LYNTON & BARNSTAPLE RAILWAY TRUST CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the Lynton & Barnstaple Railway Trust is conditional as follows:

Members may resign by notice in writing or may be removed by a majority of those present and voting at a duly convened meeting of the Board of Trustees, with membership fees being reimbursed at the discretion of the Trust.

Provided always that no members shall be removed unless:

- i. They have conducted themselves in a manner which in the judgement of the Trustees is prejudicial to the interests of the Trust or unfits them for membership of the Trust, or have by any act or conduct made known to the Trustees shown that they are no longer supportive of the aims and objects of the Trust as declared in the Memorandum.
- ii. Such members shall have at least 28 days' notice in writing of the date of the meeting of the Board of Trustees and of the grounds upon which their removal is sought.
- iii. Such members have had an opportunity to state their case to and of defending themselves before the Board of Trustees, and
- iv. Each member of the Board of Trustees shall have had at least 28 days' notice prior to the meeting that the business of the day will be or include the question of the removal of a member.

When an annual member's subscription is due for renewal the trustees can elect not to accept it, if during the preceding 12 months the member is deemed to have behaved in the manner indicated in any of the relevant sections above.

Any member who is more than six months in arrears with his membership subscription as and when due shall be deemed to have resigned his membership.
